



BeeTime



Objectives:

Reduce failures -- Increase student engagement -- Increase opportunity to provide timely, systematic, and direct support to all students -- Increase students' awareness of their performing in a particular course.

Protocol:

- All students must attend a BeeTime class. They will either be requested by a teacher for a specific academic purpose or select their teacher on-line.
- BEETime Referral Slips will be distributed during second hour.
- A teacher can refer students through the on-line referral program any day BeeTime is offered.
- Students must attend the priority teacher's class on the priority day when referred. Attendance to a Core subject: Math, Language Arts, Science and Social Studies, must take precedence over an elective subject. (See Priority Schedule below)
- No letter grade will be given for BeeTime.
- A citizenship grade will be given to each student based on the same criterial teachers use to assign citizenship grades in all other classes.
- Excessive absences and tardies in BeeTime will be handled according to the BEHS attendance policy.
